

Folsom Quilt & Fiber Guild 2018 Quilt Show

Entry Category Descriptions

1. **Art Quilt** – A quilt of any size that extensively used non-traditional techniques to show originality in theory, design, color and/or technique to be used as a piece of art.
2. **Emma Allebes Art Quilt Challenge** – See Challenge rules.
3. **Wall Quilt** – A quilt designed specifically for decorative purposes.
4. **Miniature Quilt** – Quilt must be miniature in scale and 580 sq. in. or less.
5. **Small Pieced Quilt/Item** – A quilt or decorative item that is smaller than 3500 sq. in. This category includes table runners, bed runners, pillows and placemats quilted by any method.
6. **Appliquéd Quilt** – A quilt of any size that is predominately (more than 50%) hand or machine appliquéd by maker.
7. **Large Pieced Quilt** – A quilt equal to or larger than 3500 sq. in. that is predominately (more than 50%) hand or machine pieced by one maker. Please specify class below.
 - 7A **Hand Quilted** – Quilting is predominately (more than 75%) completed by hand.
 - 7B **Quilted by Self, using Stationary Sewing Machine** – Quilting is completed by the maker of the quilt top using a sewing machine that allows the quilter to move the fabric rather than the machine.
 - 7C **Quilted by Self, using Movable Quilting Machine** – Quilting is completed by the maker of the quilt top using a machine that allows the quilter to move the machine head rather than the fabric.
 - 7D **Quilted by Professional** – Quilting is completed by a person who is compensated for their quilting expertise. (This may include the maker of the quilt top.)
8. **Mixed Techniques** – A quilt of any size using multiple techniques such as embroidery and piecing, pieced background with appliqué on top or mixed pieced and appliquéd blocks.
9. **Modern/Innovative Quilt** – A non-traditional quilt of any size that may include, for example, bold colors and prints, high contrast, graphic areas of solid color improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, alternate grid work. A quilt that brings something new to quilt making, done in an innovative manner that reflects original creativity.
10. **Machine Embroidered** – A quilt of any size where the majority of the quilt top was done on an embroidery machine. The embroidery design is the focus of the quilt.
11. **Group Quilt** – A quilt of any size created by three or more people working on a single quilt in the design, construction, or quilting with no money changing hands for their part in the process.
12. **Wearable Art Garment** – Artistic expression in clothing using traditional quilting techniques, other wearable art techniques and embellishments that result in a one-of-a-kind garment.
13. **Wearable Art Accessory** – Purses, bags, and other wearable accessories.
14. **Knitted, Crocheted or Woven Item** – Clothing or accessory using knitting, crochet, weaving.
15. **Other Fiber Item** – Other fiber techniques such as needlework that is not knitted crocheted or woven. (Examples: pictures, wall hangings, dolls.)
16. **Junior Item (Quilt or Wearable)** – A quilt or garment of any size that is made by anyone under the age of 18. The judges will evaluate junior entries as a courtesy of the Guild. No entry fees will be charged
17. **Exhibition Only/Not Judged** – This category includes entries of any size, construction, or quilting technique. These will be hung as space permits.

If a large number of entries are received in one category or class, the category or class may be divided into sub-classes by size.
